How it all started



With the passage of time the organisation grows and began to work professionally with specific issues such as Women Empowerment, Children & Youth Development revolving around education, Livelihood Sustainability, Skill Development, Health, Gender Equity and Peace Building. The organisation worked in an integrated manner with the above thematic areas under one vision and one mission. It is registered under section 7(1) of the Manipur Societies Registration Act, 1989, 12A and 80G of Income Tax Act, 1961 and under Foreign Contribution Act (FCRA).



WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

FUTGAL – Girls Football Tournament

FutGal brought about narrative shift when it comes to football. Games/sport that was considered exclusive for boys is



proven wrong. Mindset on girls has been change. Once considered to be

only in the kitchen and for household chores but now makes wings and began to fly breathing certain level of freedom. The tournament was done in collaboration with the Student Bodies & Youth Club of the areas at Saikul with the theme "Empowering women and girls through sport". FutGal becomes brand in Saikul.



Promising players were given residential football coaching. Now 11 girls actively played in the state girls' football clubs, one girl got selected for Indian Army football.

When I step into the football field the feeling was really quite different- I feel some sense of pride and connection with the game. Now being in the pitch I began to believe in my potential and believe in SELF. I regretted that I spend most of my time being just a spectator- This whole experience help me understand that one should grasp opportunity rather than waiting for it. – Miss Hoineikim, Saijang FC





I Can Lead is a women & Girls leadership building program that aims to build the leadership skills and confidence to raise their voice and enable them to take choice – voice on their welfare, and choice on their future.

Giving awareness on their rights & entitlement, making them understand what empowerment means for them. Girls and women were trained and given a space to reflect on their potential excellence and encourage to believe in themselves. Participants were able to find why they lack the courage and confidence as compare to their male counterpart. This practice helps them to be self-aware and work towards bridging the gender gap.



More women came forward and registered for Labour Card & Health Care Card under Indian government schemes.

Around 300 women are now financially independent through their income generation activities

Rural women & girls are now much more aware on their health and rights – with the improvement in the health centre women & girls health haven been improving and maternity death rate is coming down.



SKILLING

TAILORING & HANDLOOM TRAINING



So far 145 girls empowered themselves by building their vocational skills – with that skill they earn and financially become independent.

The trainees were also given the opportunity to attend various workshop and seminars on gender equality, women empowerment, financial education, leadership, etc. They become more confident and more assertive.

BRIDGE COURSE

During the Covid-19 lockdown, InSIDE-North East could reached out to **5000 children** through 72 Dream Catchers (Village Education Volunteers) in different villages of tribal geographies in North East India.

The mission is to bridge the Learning Gap of students in tribal remote geographies due to the closure down of schools because of Covid lock down and make the education happen in the village especially the marginalised community.

Around 5000 tribal children learning gap bridged successfully and engaged positively through the multi-disciplinary curriculum developed by Education Above All (EAA) which is designed in such a way that the learning is engaging, practical and fun.



LEARNING CENTRES

Empty stomach cannot learn

Apart from the Bridge Course Education children were also provided nutritious food to around 5000 children in different learning centers in 37 villages.



Every village a SCHOOL:

There is no greater joy than seeing children continuing their learning in a safe environment within their respective villages when schools are closed down due to Covid-19.



The bridge course enabled the organization to reach out to **5000** children through **72** Dream Catchers (Village Education Volunteers) in different villages of tribal remote geographies in North East India.



One of the parents said, *"I am so happy to InSIDE-North East for enabling my children to continue their learning. They are so excited learning through various fun ways and activity based. The whole learning process is very engaging and fun. They really enjoyed"*.

Children are also engaged in keeping their environment clean and teaching them about the harmful effects of plastics through practical lessons.



These way children are guided to become a conscious citizens contributing to the wellbeing of their society.

Children after being aware of the Covid-19 cause & preventive measures become the covid task force by strictly enforcing covid behavior in the family and in the village.
